



Log in to the Office 365 Admin Console and select the **Security** menu item.




Add the IYS IP address


Select **Policies & rules** from the menu on the left. A new interface opens, here click on the item **Threat policies**.



Under **Threat policies**, select the **Anti-spam** option and then click on the option **Connection filter policy**.



In the right-hand window, select **Edit connection filter policy**.



Under **Always allow messages from the following IP addresses or address range** add our IP address: **5.1.76.150**.
